Milwaukee Mitchell International Airport (MKE)

14 min drive to The Pfister Hotel

RIDE SHARING: Uber & Lyft Uber and Lyft both operate in Milwaukee. Use code VISITMKE (or visit www.lyft.com/i/visitmke) for \$10 off two rides from Lyft.

TAXI SERVICES: \$24 - \$29

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION: There is a Green Line bus service (\$2) that stops two

blocks from The Pfister Hotel, but travel time is over one hour.

O'Hare International Airport (ORD)

1 hour, 11 minute drive to The Pfister Hotel

RIDE SHARING: Uber & Lyft CAR RENTAL SERVICES

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION: Take <u>CTA Blue Line</u> from O'Hare to Clinton Station (\$5, approximately 1 hour). Walk 2 blocks to Union Station. <u>Amtrak</u> service \$19 - \$37 each way; approximately 90 minutes or less from Union Station.

Dane County Regional Airport, Madison, WI (MSN)

1 hour, 11 minute drive to The Pfister Hotel

FERRY



The <u>Lake Express Ferry</u> is a state-of-the-art auto/passenger ferry linking Milwaukee with Muskegon, Michigan. The 2-hour trip offers passengers a faster and more direct route than driving south around Lake Michigan through the Chicago area.

TRAINS



Located downtown, the recently renovated Milwaukee Intermodal Station features 14 total Amtrak departures daily between Chicago and Milwaukee, and daily direct departures between Minneapolis/St. Paul. Connect through Chicago to over 500 cities nationwide. Check the schedule here.

STREETCAR: THE HOP!



Milwaukee has a FREE city shuttle system called The Hop! Use this convenient mode of transportation to visit the great sites and restaurants around Milwaukee. There is a Hop stop located less than a block from The Pfister Hotel. Hops run every 15 – 20 minutes beginning

at 5am on the weekdays and 7am on the weekends. Here is an <u>interactive map</u> to help you navigate around Milwaukee. There is also a real-time app you can download to your smartphone to locate a Hop near you!

AUTOMOBILES



Renting a car in Milwaukee or to get to Milwaukee? Like most big cities, parking is at a premium. **Here are the rates at The Pfister Hotel** and self-park rates at the area garages. Here is a <u>map of area parking</u> <u>lots and garages</u>. Know that the city is quite walkable, Uber/Lyft accessible as well.

Whether you are renting an electric vehicle or driving down with one, knowing where you can recharge is important. Milwaukee has charging stations located all throughout the city. Plugshare, ChargeFinder, and ChargeHub are helpful tools to keep your vehicles at full charge during your stay.

BIKES & SCOOTERS



<u>Bublr Bikes</u> is a not-for-profit organization offering public biking opportunities that are integrated, accessible and convenient. Rides start at \$0.25/minute, \$24 for 24 hours or a weekender pass at \$25 for 72 hours. They offer a variety of options for the needs of the rider including side-by-side and single seat trikes for people with disabilities.



Scooters are back in Milwaukee! Residents and visitors can choose from Lime or Spin scooters. Scooters can be ridden anywhere in the city, including downtown and the Third Ward.
