Dr. Lazaroff is the Associate Program Director for the Samaritan Adult Psychiatry Residency. Since taking that role in 2016, she serves as an educator, supervisor, and mentor for Adult trainees as well as Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Fellows. She has long been an advocate at the undergraduate education level, partnering with colleagues across the Oregon State University campus to provide education and assistance for students challenged by mental health issues or seeking a career in medicine and allied fields.

Dr. Lazaroff has supervised psychiatry residents in the college mental health setting in short term therapy modalities coupled with medication management. She has also been instrumental in facilitating the training of psychology interns in a collaborative care model with medical staff in a primary care setting and with psychiatry.

Dr. Lazaroff has been a member of many professional organizations since her residency and child and adolescent fellowship. She currently serves on the AADPRT Psychotherapy Committee and the Allyship workgroup.
