Applications Due in August for ABPN 2022-23 Faculty Innovation in Education Awards and 2022-23 Research Awards

June 2, 2021, Deerfield, Ill. -- Applications for both the 2022-23 Faculty Innovation in Education Awards and the 2022-23 Research Awards are available through August 9, 2021 and August 16, 2021, respectively, from the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, Inc. (ABPN) on its website abpn.com.

The **ABPN Faculty Innovation in Education Award** supports the development of innovative education and/or evaluation projects that promote effective residency/fellowship training or lifelong learning of practicing psychiatrists and neurologists. The duration of the fellowship will normally be for two years with a maximum amount of funding of \$50,000 per year or \$100,000 total.

The 2022-23 application and accompanying materials are due to the ABPN by August 9, 2021. Recipients will be announced by December 1, 2021, with funding to start on January 1, 2022.

The **ABPN Research Award** supports research projects related to the mission of the ABPN, which is to promote and assess the competency of psychiatry and neurology candidates for initial and continuing certification (maintenance of certification). The maximum amount of funding available is \$100,000 per award and projects may take up to two years to complete.

The 2022-23 application and accompanying materials are due to the ABPN by August 16, 2021. Recipients will be announced by December 1, 2021, with funding to start on January 1, 2022.
