Dr. Ross is Associate Professor of Psychiatry at the Yale School of Medicine. As Co-Founder and Co-Chair of the National Neuroscience Curriculum Initiative, he has created novel teaching materials that are now in use at more than 200 training programs across the US and internationally. Over the past year, his team has focused on how to adapt teaching and learning into the online space.

A second major area of academic work has been studying racial and gender disparities in the educational pipeline, including in how applicants are described in their Deans' Letters and in the AOA selection process. As Director of Recruitment for the Yale Adult Psychiatry Residency Program, he led a team that restructured the recruitment process to ensure equity. He also co-founded a company that consults with residency programs to improve their ability to understand and respond to structural disparities and to identify the candidates who best align with their goals and mission.
