THE AMERICAN COLLEGE OF PSYCHIATRISTS NAMES 2024 PRITE[®] AND CHILD PRITE[®] FELLOWS

Chicago, March 2024 – The American College of Psychiatrists (The College) has announced the selection of two psychiatry residents – Chad Donahue, M.D., Ph.D., and Hilary Pang, M.D., MSc., and two child psychiatry fellows – Chetan Bhat, M.D., and Liana Lau, M.D. – to serve as Fellows on its PRITE (Psychiatry Resident In-Training Examination[®]) Editorial Board.

Taken by nearly all psychiatry residents and fellows in the United States, both the PRITE and CHILD PRITE serve as an educational resource for psychiatry residents, fellows and training programs. The exams allow individual residents and fellows to compare their knowledge base and clinical skills to their peers and offers training directors an insight into the performance of their residents/fellows, enabling them to make their programs more effective.

In order to include the views of psychiatry residents and fellows who sit for the exam, The College selects residents and fellows from training programs throughout the United States and Canada to serve on the PRITE Editorial Board. In addition to being invited to the Annual Meeting of The College during both years of Fellowship, the PRITE and CHILD PRITE Fellows are required to attend two PRITE Editorial Board meetings during their Fellowship. PRITE and CHILD PRITE Fellows participate in the question writing process by developing an assigned number of questions and then editing and referencing exam items.

- **Chad Donahue, M.D., Ph.D.,** is a third-year psychiatry resident at University of Pittsburgh Western Psychiatric Hospital (Pittsburgh, PA) (PRITE)

- Chetan Bhat, M.D., is a first-year child psychiatry fellow at University of California, San Diego (San Diego, CA) (CHILD PRITE)
- Liana Lau, M.D., is a first-year child psychiatry fellow at Mount Sinai Elmhurst Hospital (Elmhurst, NY) (CHILD PRITE)
